Principal's Report: Presented by Dayl Lynn Shaddock

- Vision for this year is "Choosing to be the best version of me."
- 30 teachers received training this summer in using productive words.
- We have 4 new teachers, a new school counselor, music teacher, ESL teacher and building secretary.
- Mr. Seylar, the new music teacher, would like to direct a school play, "Annie" in the spring. Participation would be considered an after school club that would start in January. He is requesting \$550 to purchase the license. The discussion was tabled for a future meeting.

Treasurers Report: Presented by Camille Wenger

- Budget for 2018-19 school year was reviewed.
- The budget was formulated with less anticipated profit as well as fewer expenditures than last year due to losing staff and students to Winding Creek.
- Family activities category was broken down more.

Motion to approve the budget was made by: Jenni Gery. Second: Ashlee Zuvich. All in favor.

Old Business:

- 1. Chris Cain presented for Cub Scout Pack 196. This will be the first year for family scouting with girls included. Kickoff meeting with be held on August 28th from 6:30-8pm at the pavilion behind the pool in Hampden park. All are welcome to attend. The scouts will now be required to complete 1-3 hours of community service with the PTO. Kevin Wehnan will be taking over as Cubmaster next year.
- 2. Thanks to donations in memory of former teacher, Ginny Walters, Buddy Benches have been purchased and will be delivered tomorrow.

New Business:

- 1. Mrs. Proctor is requesting funds to purchase Rooted in Reading for first grade. This is a Comprehensive reading program. The PTO already approved funding for Rooted in Reading for second and third grades. The license and materials can be used every year. The manufacturers are releasing one month at a time at approximately \$80/mo. Motion to approve up to \$800 to fund Rooted in Reading for first grade was made by Jenni Gery. Second: Tina Shehan. All in favor.
- 3. Ms. Blaker is requesting earbuds for her 5th grade class. It was suggested that the PTO purchase a large quantity of earbuds to have available for all students in need and discussion followed. Motion to approve \$120 for 200 earbuds was made by Nikki Heckard. Second: Chris Catania. All in favor.

- 4. Race For Education will be held on Sept. 28. Our incentives are schoolwide this year in keeping with the new district policy. We have been soliciting annual sponsorships and so far have received \$1750 in sponsorships.
- 5. Updated Bylaws were reviewed. Wording was changed in some areas and the Cub Scout Pack is now represented in our Bylaws. Motion to approve the new Bylaws was made by Nikki Heckard. Second: Jenni Gery. All in favor.
- 6. The district calendar has the incorrect time for our PTO meetings. Meetings will start at 6:00pm, not at 7:00pm.
